## Strategy:

This podcast project can be used in several other Humber courses:

- **Event Planning and Management Course:** Students from this course can assist with organizing and coordinating the Podcast Launch Event, handling logistics such as venue selection and guest management, ensuring the event runs smoothly for their final project. Additionally they can collaborate with students from the Product Management class to design visually engaging booths.
- **Marketing and Branding Development Courses:** Students from the Bachelor of Commerce programs enrolled Marketing, Digital Marketing, Brand Development as well as other Marketing programs available at Humber can use the podcast project to develop marketing strategies, social media campaigns, and finally, develop audience growth techniques, offering students real-world insights into content and brand development and how to market a digital product.
- **Digital Media and Communications:** Students from the Bachelor of Digital Communications can use this podcast project as an example of content creation, teaching students about audio production, the art of storytelling, and how to effectively communicate to their target audience. It provides an opportunity for students to practice their writing, speaking, and editing skills while learning how to engage the audience through digital storytelling.

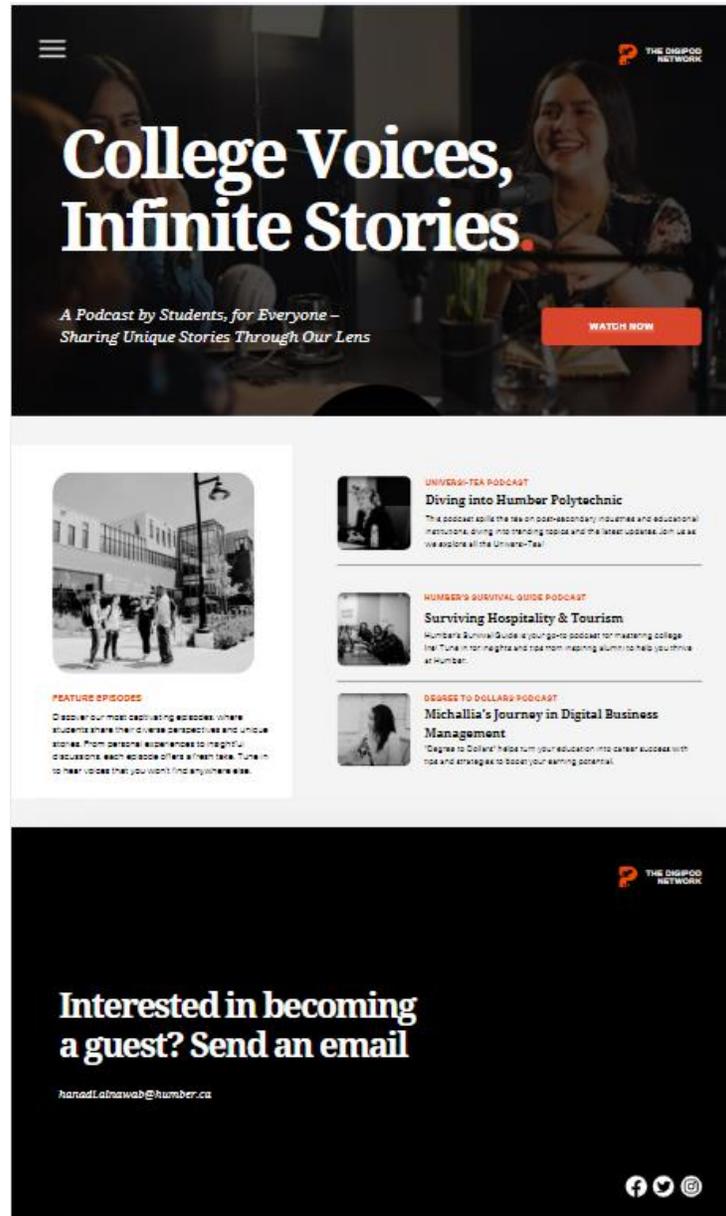
## Potential Partnerships

- **The Faculty of Media, Creative Arts and Design Program** can play a vital role in the podcast project. Students from the Photography, Videography program can film the episodes and capture behind-the-scenes of the making of each episode, from the planning stages to the recording process, while ensuring high-quality visuals and sound. This will allow students from the videography program to gain hands-on experience while honing in on their skills.
- Having **industry guests to serve as judges** for our podcast launch event, where they will vote on their favourite podcast. The winning group will earn an exciting opportunity to host a segment on Radio Humber, gaining real-world experience and broadening their reach within the Humber community.

- **Collaborating with IGNITE**, the official student union at Humber Polytechnic and the University of Guelph-Humber to increase student engagement and attract more listeners and guests to the podcast launch event. The student union's platform is highly visible to the Humber and Guelph-Humber community and is a great source for information and events. Having a banner or feature section on their website not only helps promote the event but also introduces the podcasts to a wider audience of students, driving interest and audience growth.

# The Digipod Website Reimagined

New Layout:



To revamp the website, I would focus on creating a clean, user-friendly layout with three key sections: Home Page, Featured Episodes, and Contact Us.

- **Home Page:** The homepage will feature a banner with a brief overview of the podcast's purpose and a "Watch Now" button that links directly to the Digipod YouTube page for access to all episodes.

- **Featured Episodes:** This section will display the most recent or popular episodes, with each episode accompanied by a brief description and a thumbnail image. I'll use the #D9462C color to highlight the name of each podcast. The background will feature #F4F4F4 to maintain a clean design, and the primary color #000000 will be used for text and headers to ensure visual consistency with the overall theme.

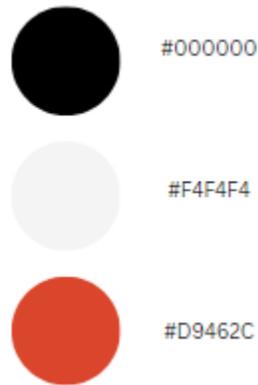

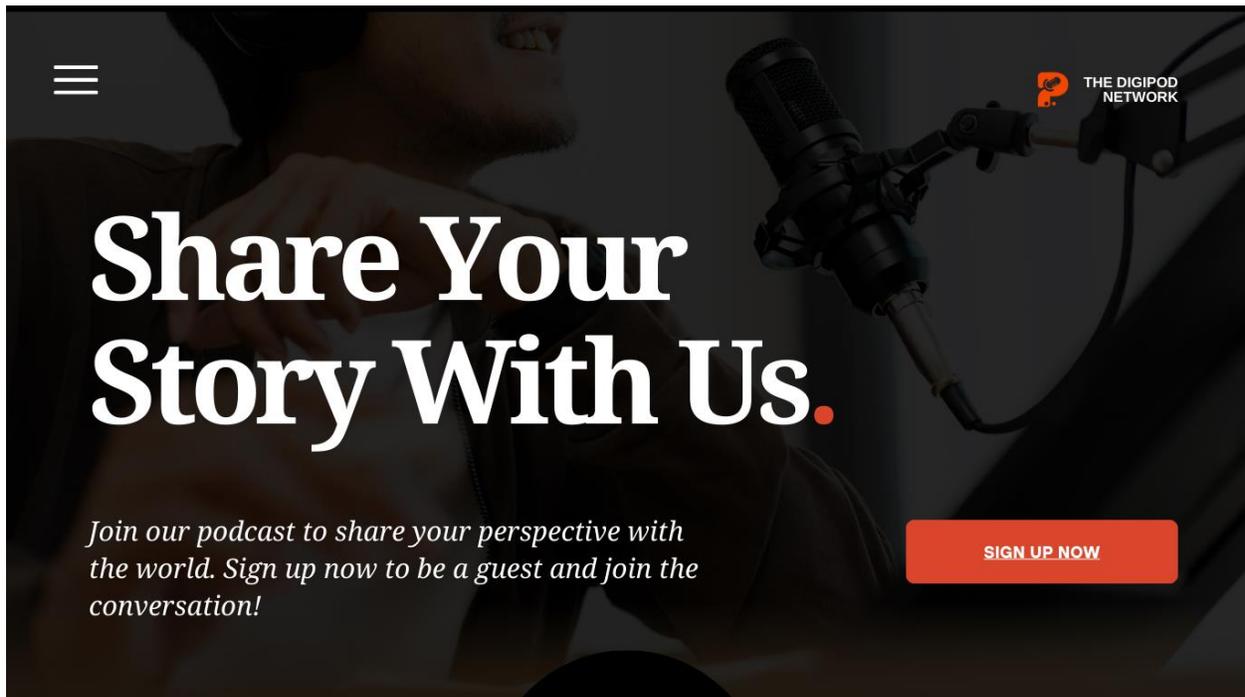

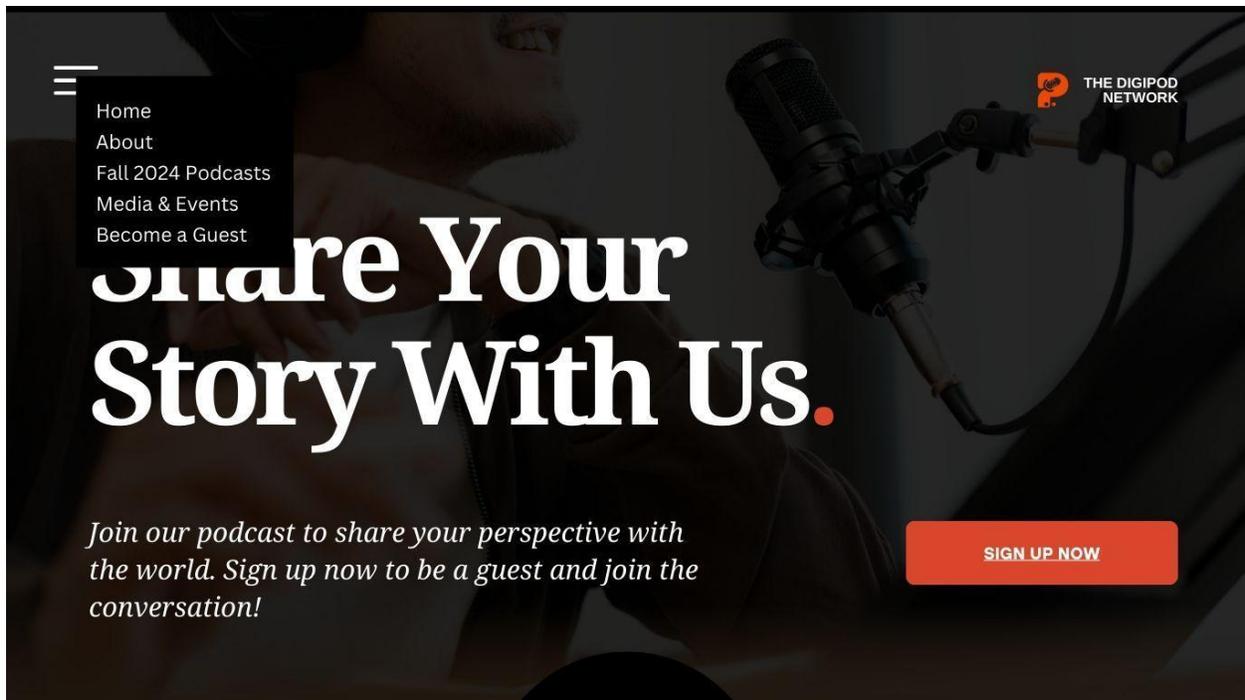




By using a distinct colour scheme that incorporates #000000, #F4F4F4, and #D9462C, the website will not only match the branding but also create a modern design that draws attention to key information.



In addition, I would also include a secondary banner designed to encourage users to sign up as future guests. This banner would feature a call to action, "Share Your Story With Us" with a brief description as well as an eye-catching button such as "Sign Up Now" that leads directly to the "Become a Guest" page. This addition would help grow the podcast's guest pool and foster a sense of community engagement.



In addition to the sign-up banner, I would create a dedicated page titled "Become a Guest" to further encourage people to sign up and share their stories on the podcast. This page would provide a clear explanation of the benefits of being a guest. The page would include a simple form for users to fill out, collecting details such as their name, contact information, and a brief description of the topic or story they'd like to share.

**NOTE:** When users click the "Sign Up Now" button on the secondary banner, it will navigate them to the "Become a Guest".

To support the podcast launch event, I utilized the Humber employee directory to connect with members of the Faculty of Media, Creative Arts and Design in search of:

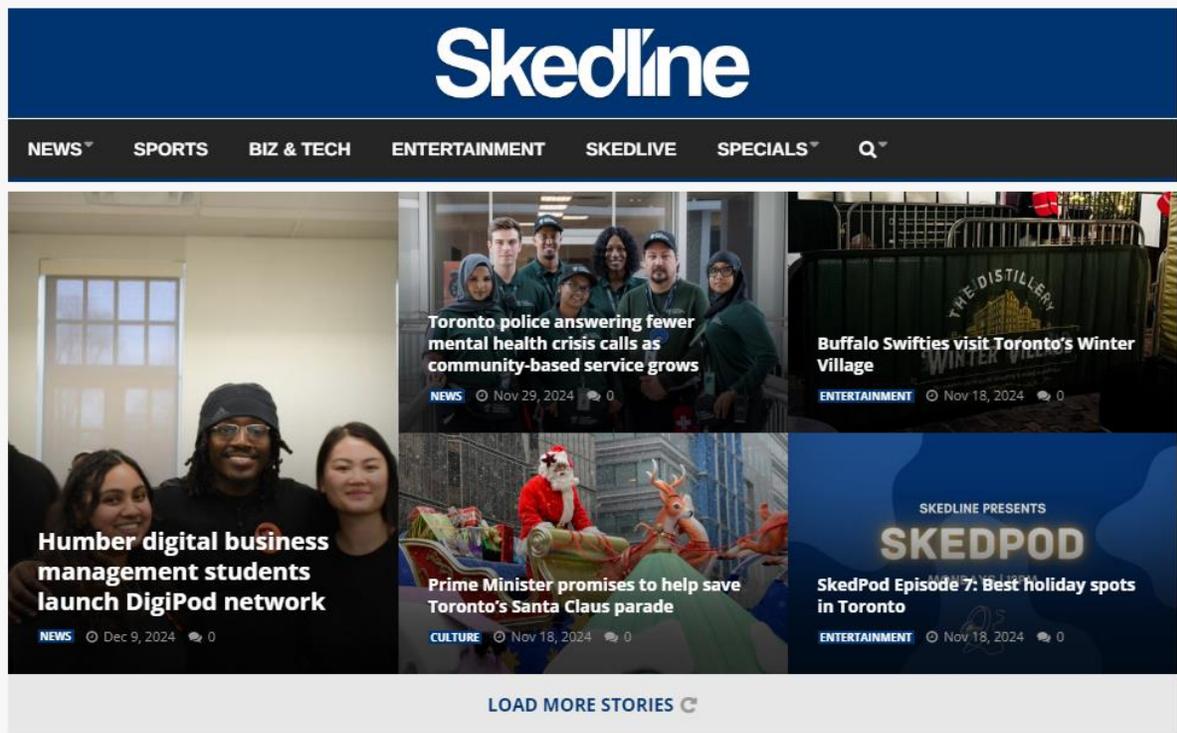

Based on the responses I received back, I was able to secure:

- **Victoria Hincapie Gomez, a 4th year journalism student** at Humber's Lakeshore campus and reporter for Skedline News (a breaking news website that features the works of Humber ITAL's Bachelor of Journalism students) to interview podcast group members and write a post-event article highlighting the launch event on the Skedline News website.



- **Public service announcement on Radio Humber** at 4pm, 5pm and 7pm starting on November 25th leading up to the launch event, with the help of Noah Scanga. (See *Appendix B*)
- **An Instagram story post** from the Faculty of Media, Creative Arts and Design social media page (@humbermediaarts), with the help of Katrina Quitevis. (See *Appendix E*)

## Suggestions for the Future

- In the future there could be an opportunity to take a trip to the Spotify office (any other podcast platform) or the Idea Lab at Humber, to teach students on the do's and don'ts of creating a podcast as well as pointers on how to film a good episode.
- I also believe there would be a good opportunity to extend the duration of the podcast launch event beyond an hour, as an hour tends to go by extremely fast. This would allow more meaningful interactions and for teams to cover additional segments such as Q&A for the audience to fully engage with the podcasts.
- In order to increase engagement and marketing by attracting more listeners, create vibrant posters with QR codes and post them around campus in high-traffic areas such as cafeterias, libraries and dorms to drive listeners to the podcast launch event.

## Best Practices

### **Research What Current and Potential Students Like to Listen To**

In order to create relevant and engaging podcasts, students should research the interests of their target audience before deciding on an idea. This could involve conducting user research such as surveys, interviews, or reviewing online forums. Popular podcast platforms like Spotify and Apple Podcasts also provide data on popular genres, trending topics, and demographics, which can offer insights into what students are currently listening to.

### **Prepare a List of Questions in Advance to Send to Their Guests**

Planning ahead is crucial for a successful podcast interview. Students should spend time researching their guest's background and expertise, and creating a well written list of questions to guide the conversation while leaving room for follow up questions. Sending the list of questions in advance allows the guest to prepare, while ensuring the conversation flows smoothly, avoiding any awkward pauses.

### **If Their Guest Will Be Joining Online, Send the Meeting Invite Ahead of Time**

For guests who will be joining remote via Zoom, Riverside.fm or any other meeting platform, it's important to ensure everything runs smoothly. Students should send a meeting invite well in advance, allowing the guest time to test the platform they'll be using as they may be unfamiliar with the platform. This helps avoid delays or disruptions on the day of recording.

### **If You Are New to Podcasting Equipment (Microphone, Camera, Monitor, etc.), Spend Time Before the Film Date to Learn How the Equipment Works**

Familiarity with podcasting equipment is essential for a smooth recording process. Students who are new to using tools like microphones, cameras, and other equipment should take the time to learn how each equipment works before it's time to record. This includes understanding

how to set up and test the equipment, how to adjust the settings, how to connect the cables as well as how to troubleshoot common issues.

### **Create a Fun and Engaging Podcast Booth**

Part of the podcast launch event is to create visually appealing and interactive booths that attract guests. By incorporating creative elements such as posters, decorations, branded merchandise, or interactive features like a listening station, can make any booth stand out, creating an inviting and memorable experience for the guests. This effort not only boosts interest in the podcast but also demonstrates event planning and promotional skills.

### **Create a Mailing List for Future Episodes**

The podcast must go on! To keep users engaged after the event, students should create a mailing list for guests who expressed interest in their podcast. This mailing list can be used to share updates regarding upcoming episodes with teasers or exclusive behind-the-scenes content. Collecting emails during the event can ensure students maintain contact with their eager audience of listeners.

## Learning Outcome

Overall this project has taught me the importance of strategic planning, effective communication and visual storytelling. I learned how to effectively communicate the purpose of the podcast to generate interest among faculty and staff by sending initial emails to sought out program coordinators. In the future, I would like to reach out to faculty members earlier in the process and include all the event details in the initial email to ensure smoother communication and more timely collaboration, as well as an image attachment of the poster.
